

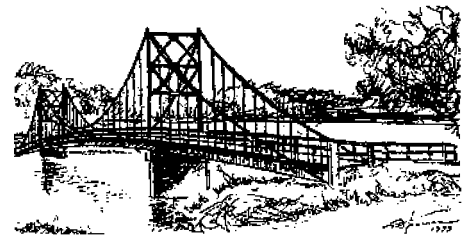

Dear Sir or Madam:

In the matter of the above application, the town of Beaver, Arkansas, is concerned that we may not have a full opportunity to register our strongest opposition to the northern-most primary or alternative routes proposed by the applicant, SWEPCO..

We have received a notice package, including a CD disk, dated March 28, 2013, from SWEPCO's retained lawyers. We are informed Beaver will receive an invitation from the PSC to comment on the application's impacts on our area, after which we will have a 60-day comment period.

**We have not yet received the PSC's invitation to comment. Please send it on at the proper time, as we wish to register our opposition as strongly and as effectively as we can, when we receive your invitation.**

There are few enough remaining undeveloped, naturally beautiful areas in "the Natural State" of Arkansas. This northwest corner is one of those few. Thousands of people come from all over the United States to visit, stay and hike in Beaver's RV and camping park. It is so beautiful that the Arkansas tourism office uses footage of the little town of Beaver's waterfront and its uniquely scenic one-lane wooden suspension bridge over the White River in its advertising literature and TV spots, nationwide.

It would be sad indeed if the PSC permitted that very scenic view to be despoiled by SWEPCO's proposed primary or alternate high voltage monopole powerline route, with its 150 to 200 foot wide clearcut easement! We shudder at the thought of SWEPCO's toxic defoliation chemical cocktail being sprayed regularly and leaching into our groundwater drinking water pools as well as into the waters of 40-mile long Table Rock Lake, which extends into Missouri as far as Branson, gradually poisoning the people and wildlife relying on those waters.
