**OG&E Corporation Chairman, President and CEO Peter
Delaney to Speak at Clinton School December 14**

(Little Rock) – As the next in its series of lectures by utility executives as part of its Sustainable Energy Resources Collaborative, the Arkansas Public Service Commission is co-sponsoring with the Clinton School of Public Service a lecture on December 14 by OG&E Corporation Chairman, President, and CEO Peter B. Delaney. Prior to joining OG&E Energy, the parent company of Oklahoma Gas & Electric Co. and Enogex, a natural gas pipeline business, Mr. Delaney completed a 15-year investment banking career on Wall Street, where he specialized in corporate finance.

The brown-bag lunch event will be held at the Clinton School on the grounds of the Clinton Presidential Center in Little Rock.

Pete Delaney has a bachelor's degree in economics with distinction from the University of Virginia and a master's degree in business administration from Tulane University. It is expected that Mr. Delaney will address some of the climate and environmental challenges now facing utilities, the United States, and the world and will discuss OG&E's recent acceptance of a federal Stimulus grant for Smart Grid projects in Oklahoma and Arkansas. A question and answer session will follow Mr. Delaney's prepared remarks.
