NOTICE

Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) provides the Commission the following notice in connection with the construction of the John W. Turk, Jr. power plant:


1. In Order No. 11 issued November 21, 2007, as modified by Order No. 13 issued December 31, 2007, the Commission granted SWEPCO a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (CECPN) to construct and operate the John W. Turk, Jr. power plant (Turk Plant) located in Hempstead County, Arkansas.

2. On May 13, 2010, the Arkansas Supreme Court reversed and remanded the Commission's grant of the CECPN for the Turk Plant.

3. SWEPCO hereby notifies the Commission that the construction and operation of the Turk Plant will proceed in accordance with the exemption set forth in Ark. Code Ann. § 23-18-504 (a)(5). Accordingly, SWEPCO will not seek to recover the costs of the Turk Plant in rates subject to regulation by the Commission.
