ERRATA ORDER

The first full paragraph on page 103 of Order No. 32, issued on January 17, 2014, that begins with "I find Route 109 ..." is amended to read as follows:

I find Route 109 fulfills the requirements of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-18-501 *et seq.*, and is both feasible and reasonable. The route will facilitate the transmission of electricity as required by the needs assessment. All routes share the fundamental elements of height and type of pole intended to be constructed. All routes are roughly the same length and use the same width for the right-of-way. While Route 109 will cost slightly more than Route 33, cost is not the only factor to be considered. Route 109 is longer, and it crosses more undeveloped lands with larger parcels. As such, Route 109 has a lower residential proximity and visibility, and crosses fewer parcels

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and major roads. Although Route 109 extends into Missouri and will require SWEPCO to obtain additional regulatory approvals from the appropriate Missouri agency, it has a lesser impact on residential areas and a lesser aesthetic impact. After weighing the evidence presented in this case and in consideration of the above listed factors, I find Routes 33 and 108 are unreasonable, and Route 109 is the only reasonable route.

Additionally, paragraph (f) on page 115 of Order No. 32 is amended to read as follows:


(f) SWEPCO shall comply with the new RPPs Rule 6.05(a) or Rule 6.05(b), applicable to proceedings for certificates of public convenience and necessity [Ark. Code Ann. § 23-3-202 *et seq.*], but by this order made applicable to the CECPN hereby being granted. The required construction report shall be filed in the captioned docket.
