ORDER

On January 29, 2016, Entergy Arkansas, Inc. (“EAI”) filed its Application for approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, along with supporting testimony. On February 5, 2016, Midcontinent Independent System Operator (“MISO”) filed a Petition to Intervene, in this Docket. On February 19, 2016, MISO’s Petition to Intervene was granted by Order No. 2.

On March 11, 2016, the General Staff (“Staff”) of the Arkansas Public Service Commission proposed a procedural schedule in this matter:

EAI’s Rebuttal	noon, April 22, 2016; and,
Hearing	9:30 a.m., May 3, 2016.
