**ORDER FOR A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE  
AND HEARING DATE**

On March 23, 2016, Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation (“AECC”) filed, with the Arkansas Public Service Commission (“Commission” or “APSC”), an Application for Approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to construct, own, and operate certain transmission facilities in Greene County, Arkansas. In support of its Application, AECC also filed the supporting Direct Testimonies of Curtis Q. Warner, AECC’s Director – Compliance and Support, and Forest Kessinger, AECC’s Director – Transmission Coordination and Planning. In AECC’s CCN Application, AECC requested a final order date of June 14, 2016, given AECC’s desired in-service date.


On April 13, 2016, the General Staff (“Staff”) of the APSC and AECC proposed a different final order date, as well as the following procedural schedule:
